3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw.

- Coin toss or at the discretion of the Captains and the Committee.

THE JACQUES PALOUME TOURNAMENT

The Origins of this amazing tournament started back in 1949 when then Captain of East Grinstead 1^{st} XI Harry Gabain, who had lived in France before the war, renewed contacts with his friends from Dieppe, and received an invitation to take a hockey side their at Easter.

The following year 1950, Dieppe were the guests of East Grinstead and brought with them a number of players from Rouen, and sure enough the following year 1951 Rouen hosted their first festival. For some reason the festival was not held in 1952 but was back at East Grinstead in 1953 with our friends from Flottbek first being invited to Rouen in 1954. Flottbek's first trip to East Grinstead was in 1959 and at the May Bank holiday of that year both East Grinstead and Rouen were invited to Flottbek for the first time (two festivals in one year – very good!).

From this point the festival became 'triangular', with the three host clubs taking it in turn to host the festival.

The main tournament trophy for the men was presented by Flottbek in 1962 and was later re-christened in 1968 The Jacque Paloumé Trophy in memory of our great friend from Rouen who was tragically killed in a car accident.

The Mike Leman / Ian Westwood Cup

This is presented at each tournament in memory of Mike and Ian from East Grinstead who were tragically killed in a car accident in 1985. Mike and Ian were two great personalities of the festival and this Cup is presented to the person who in the opinion of the 3 Paloumé Team Captains the festival could not have taken place without. Holder – Anna (Flottbek)

Emilie Trophy

In memory of Emilie from Rouen.

Originally this trophy was to be for the best goalkeeper of the tournament. This has now changed and it is awarded to the person who

in the opinion of the 3 Paloumé Team Captains has most entered into the spirit of the festival and interacted between teams. Holder – Auty (EG)

Player of the Tournament

Voted for by the 3 Paloumé Team Captains. Holder – Aram (Flottbek)

Big Ben

Awarded to, shall we say, the most sociable team... Decided by tradition! Holders – EG

Paloume Trophies

Awarded to who was sober enough to play good hockey all day. Holder – Flottbek (girls) Rouen (boys)

SEBASTIAN WOLFF FOUNDATION

The Foundation was set up in memory of Sebastian Wolff from Flottbek, and its aim is to enable young hockey players from Hamburg, Rouen and East Grinstead to visit each other's cities to continue their education or employment whilst playing hockey at the same time, with living costs being covered, but not personal expenses.

It also sponsors the annual junior festival between our 3 clubs. This year, it is in Rouen from the 5^{th} to 7^{th} July.

It is a further testament to the on-going strength of friendship between our clubs that an increasing number of participants from previous Junior Festivals now join us regularly at Easter.


